Programme Brief on Mission and Ministry Opportunities

Ministry and sharing with Vicky's young people in Kampala

This week is about meeting young people who live in a shanty town area in Kampala who Vicky mentors from London (Vicky is a Kampala girl who now does youth work in the east End of London among Young Africans). These young people in Kampala do not have a church but are growing Christians. The task is to spend time with them, and encourage and nurture them spiritually and anchor them in a fellowship with good Christian leadership. Before the team leaves the UK, Vicky will have met with Sarah and briefed her on the specific ministry needs.

Mission Week with Pastor Emmy

This week is about sharing ministry with pastor Emmy's young people. Emmy and his wife Sarah, in addition to their own children, have a household of 23 orphans, he pastors several churches and runs an orphanage school. The week will involve youth outreach, working in the orphanage school, prison visiting and evangelism, and lots of worship!

Mission & Discipleship Week with John & Poppy Spens

This week involves staying with John and Poppy in Yei in Southern Sudan. John and Poppy work with CMS Ireland and run a Vocational Training College (where building, plumbing, electrical and carpentry skills are taught), a Medical Clinic, a Craft Centre and shop and a primary school. It is an experience of working with Missionaries in a very structured environment and will involve teaching in the primary School, helping expand the Craft skills programme, doing sport with the students and helping in the Medical Clinic.

Team Member Profiles

Sarah is 24 and works as a Primary School Teacher in Inner City London. She is a past pupil of St David's College, has learned strategies to overcome her dyslexia which led her to success through her A levels and University. She is highly creative, a natural mentor, a visionary and a totally committed Christian. She has a supportive Christian family and belongs to a dynamic church in London. This is probably Sarah's 6th 'tour' of Uganda and east Africa. She pioneered the possibility of taking young people to John Njendahayo in 2004, in 2005 she joined the first St David's Pupil Team as an activity leader and in 2007 led a Leeds Met University Student Team. In addition to these trips to Uganda she has been involved with helping on child care teams for Wycliffe Associates in Uganda and Kenya.

Fran is 24 and an English graduate. She has been working recently as a Special needs support worker and has much experience of special needs children. She is a deeply committed Christian and has prophetic and intercessory giftings....she listens to God and prays and speaks into people's lives!! She has a supportive Christian family and is a member of a dynamic church in Nottingham. In 2006 she spent 6 weeks on a similar Mission and Ministry tour of Uganda, spending a week with pastor Emmy and a week in a remote mountain village in Southern Uganda as well as doing ministry in shanty towns in Kampala.

Danni is 17 and is at the end of her L6th year doing A levels in Design, Geography and English. She is a highly gifted designer and her design work has been selected for inclusion in this year's Innovation Award Competition for the best design work in Wales at A level standard. She loves working with children and is passionate about worship and a great singing voice. She has a supportive Christian family and is a member of a strong Family Christian Fellowship in North Wales. In 2007 she went with her church to work in a shanty town in Mexico on a project to build new houses.

Dave is 19, a GAP year student at St David's College and from Australia. He is a games player and strong activities type person. He is excellent with children and brings a strong male presence to the team. He has been a leader in his youth group and in his school Christian fellowship from an early age and he has been on missions to Aborigine communities. He loves worship and enjoys singing in the worship group. He has a supportive Christian family and is a member of a large dynamic church in Australia.
